**SECTION I
NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

The Waste Commission of Scott County (Commission) is seeking proposals for a 2021 LP fork truck with an 8000 lb. capacity (or equivalent). These specifications are intended to describe the minimum requirements necessary to furnish (1) LP 8000 lb. fork truck with a cascade rotating bale clamp opening range 22” – 75” (or equivalent). Bidders are requested to bid the fork truck as outlined on the bid sheet.

All units must meet all federal, state and local safety and pollution requirements.

Bidders must submit a fully completed bid specification sheet on each vehicle submitted for proposal. Literature or specification sheets giving detailed information on each fork truck, and bale clamping system being bid shall be provided with each proposal.

Bidders must submit accurate delivery dates. Failure to comply with these commitments can result in the loss of the award and future disqualification. Bidders agree to provide a like fork truck with clamp until the purchased truck is received for any time after the agreed upon delivery date.

The 2021 equipment shall be a new, current, standard production model and carry a 1-year, full warranty by the manufacturer. None of the accessories are to be removed for any reason unless noted in these specifications. All requirements not meeting the specifications and all items exceeding specifications must be noted on the bid sheet along with dollar values for these items. Deviation from the specifications must be listed on the bid sheet along with substitutions and may result in rejection of the bid.

The following specifications are intended to be minimum requirements. It is the intent of these specifications to describe a unit that best meets the needs of the Commission for material transport of 5000 lbs. (8000 lb. truck considering weight of bale clamp) and not to exclude any potential bidders.

The bidder must be a factory authorized dealer capable of supplying service and factory guarantee. The bidder must carry an adequate supply of parts and maintain an established local parts and service center for all units bid. Bidders are not limited to submitting one bid. The Commission will consider total life cycle cost (operating costs, initial purchase cost and resale value), warranties, delivery date, service, training, safety, and references in making the award.

The Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any technicality, informality or irregularity in the bids received. The Commission further reserves the right to award the bid to the lowest responsible bidder whose offer best responds in quality, fitness and capacity to the requirements of the proposed work or usage and therefore is in the best interest of the Commission. The Commission is a tax-exempt governmental body and qualifies for appropriate discounts. All units must meet all local, state and federal requirements. The Commission is not responsible for delays occasioned by email. The Commission will not consider any proposal responses that are received later than the date and time stated above.

SECTION II SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

2021 LP FORK TRUCK AND CLAMP SPECIFICATIONS

8000 lb. lift capacity

Fuel: LP Gas

Cascade 50D rotating bale clamp (or equivalent)

Two-stage mast, minimum raised height 190", maximum resting height of 102" - 5 degrees forward and 6 degrees back tilt with a free lift and 360 degree rotating mast.

Tires - solid rubber, cushioned with traction tread on front tires

Full flow oil filter - spin on

Engine enclosure with guarding to protect from fire hazards in a recycling environment

Air Filters - dry type with auto-dust ejection and service indicator

Radiator guards

Engine hour meter

Gauges - temperature, oil, air, fuel, and others considered necessary by manufacturer

Muffler - low noise

Transmission - auto forward and reverse

Hydraulic controls - four lever or comparable levers to operate attachments

Back up alarm

Lights - two front headlights, front and rear blue lights. Unit shall be wired so blue lights are on when unit is running

Warning horn - access on steering wheel

Suspension seat - adjustable with safety belt

Paint - entire unit with factory paint job

WARRANTY:

Written unlimited warranty for a minimum of 1yr/2000 hrs, including parts, labor, service calls and travel costs. Include extended warranty options and cost in submittal. Bidder to submit detailed, written warranty on parts, labor and service calls, and to note any and all exceptions. During the warranty period, repair parts falling under this warranty must be received by Waste Commission of Scott County within 48 hours after an order is placed. If parts are not received within 48 hours, the bidder agrees to supply the Commission an equivalent replacement fork truck until the part arrives and machine is back in service.
